



Tag Needle Book Tutorial

Finished size: 2 1/2" x 5"

Supplies Needed:

- 4 pieces Camel Wool Felt 2 1/2" x 5" each for outside of tag
- 3 pieces Rustic Crimson Wool Felt 2" x 3 3/4" each for inside pages of tag and heart
 - 1 small button
 - 9" ribbon for tie
 - Size 8 Brown Pearl Cotton
 - Quilter's Choice Basting Glue



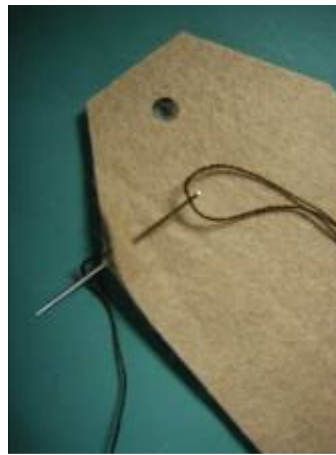
1. Cut four rectangles 2 1/2" x 5". Cut top at an angle to resemble a tag shape. (Follow template given).
2. Use paper punch to cut hole in each of the four rectangles.
3. Cut two rectangles 2" x 3 3/4" for pages of tag.
4. Cut one heart from remaining rectangle.
5. Glue heart to one tag.
6. Sew heart to tag using a running stitch.
7. Sew button to center of heart.



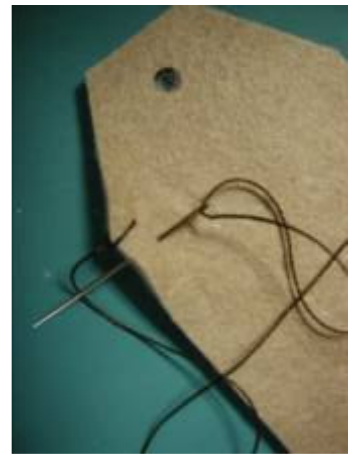
8. Apply thin bead of glue to outside edges of one layer of the back of the tag. Position second layer on top of bottom layer.



9. Blanket stitch around the three straight edges of the tag, starting at the upper left corner. Hide knot between layers of tag.



10. To blanket stitch, place needle through both layers approximately 1/4" in from edge of felt.
11. Bring needle over excess thread to form an "L."



12. Form second stitch in same manner, take stitch through both layers to back side of tag, then bringing needle over excess thread to form an "L."



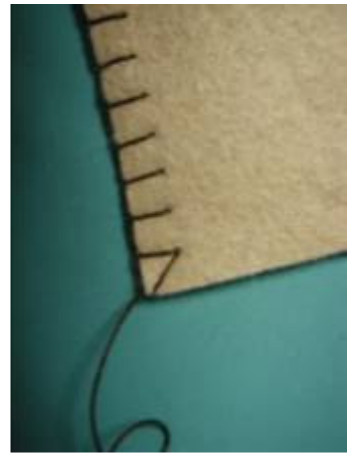
13. Continue Blanket Stitching.



14. Continue Blanket Stitching down the side of the tag.



15. At the corner, form an angled stitch in the same manner, sharing the hole from the previous stitch.



16. Continue stitching around corner.



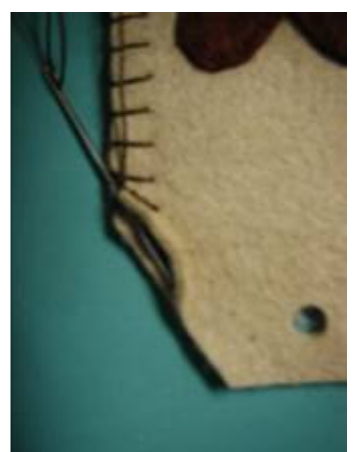
17. Continue stitching around corner.



18. Continue stitching across end of tag.



19. Finish stitching last straight side of tag.



20. Hide knot between layers of the tag.
21. Repeat for front two layers of the tag.



22. Center the 2" x 3 3/4" rectangles on top of the back of the tag to form the pages of the needle book.



23. Layer the front of the tag on top of the pages and the back of the tag.



24. Sew a running stitch across the tag, taking care to catch all layers of the pages and tag.



25. Complete running stitch, hiding knot between the layers.



26. View of completed stitching.



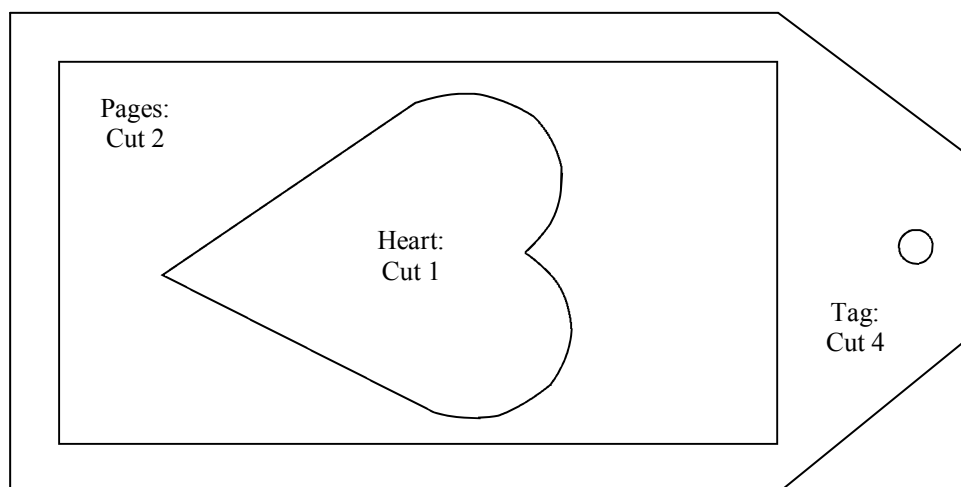
27. Fold the 9" length of ribbon in half. Slide folded end of ribbon through hole in tag.



28. Bring tails of ribbon through loop created by fold. Pull to tighten.



29. Enjoy your new needle book.



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
